ORAL ORDER

2 15-10-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends her arrest in connection
with Patepur P.S. Case No. 147 of 2019 registered under Section
30(a) of the Bihar Excise Act.

The accusation is of recovery of 5.250 litres Indian
made foreign liquor from the house of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that, in
fact, 5.250 litres Indian made foreign liquor are said to be
recovered from the joint house, in which, petitioner, who is lady,
used to reside but she had no knowledge about keeping the
aforesaid liquor by male family members of her joint family.
The petitioner, who is lady, has no criminal antecedent.



Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioner be released on bail, in the event of her arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Learned Additional Sessions Judge-II-cum-Excise Court, Vaishali at Hajipur, in connection with Patepur P.S. Case No. 147 of 2019, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
