3 10-01-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and counsel
appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioner is in custody in connection with
Alamnagar (Ratwara O.P.) P.S. Case No. 167 of 2018 for the
offence under Section 302/34 of the Indian Penal Code and
Section 27 of the Arms Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that
petitioner has no criminal antecedent. Learned counsel for the
petitioner further submits that there is no eye witness to the
firing on the victim.

In this case diary was called for. Learned APP appearing
on behalf of the State with reference to case diary would submit that
informant has claimed that she has seen the petitioner and other co-
accused fleeing away from the place of occurrence.



Considering the fact that petitioner has no criminal antecedent and he is in custody since 04.08.2018, let the petitioner named above, is directed to be released on bail after 21.3.2019 on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Shree Shiv Kumar, Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Udakishunganj, District- Madhepura, in connection with Alamnagar (Ratwara O.P.) P.S. Case No. 167 of 2018.
