2 30-09-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the

learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioner is in custody since 26.08.2019 in
connection with Excise Case No. 150C-2 of 2019 registered for
the offence under Sections 30(a) of the Bihar prohibition and
Excise Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
alleged recoveries were not from the conscious possession of
the petitioner but from the house which is in joint possession of
many others. The petitioner has got no criminal antecedent.

Considering the aforementioned facts and
circumstances and the period of custody, let the petitioner,
above named, be released on bail on his furnishing bail bond of



Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the court of learned Additional Sessions Judge-2nd-cum-Special Judge, Excise Act, Begusarai in connection with Excise Case No. 150C-2 of 2019.
