3 22-11-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned
Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under Sections 341, 323, 307, 379, 504/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

The prosecution case as lodged by the informant is that on 27.02.2018 at about 7AM informant was going to Jehanabad to appear at matriculation examination. It is further alleged that he was interrupted by all the accused persons at Mirabigha more and Iron@ Bittu pointed pistol on his head and other accused persons assaulted his with rod and Gulshan Kumar snatched his gold ring and unknown persons snatched his gold necklace.



Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners are innocent, committed no offence and have been falsely implicated in this case. He submits that the police after investigation submitted charge-sheet against all the accused persons and the learned court below took cognizance under Sections 341, 323, 307, 504/34 IPC. Learned counsel further submits that the injuries upon the informant have been found to be simple in nature. He further submits that petitioners have no criminal antecedent.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioners, above named, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of the order, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (rupees ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned S.D.J.M., Jehanabad in connection with Makhdumpur (Tehta) Police Station Case No. 50 of 2018, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
