ORAL ORDER

2 16-10-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in connection with Barh P.S. Case No. 326 of 2019 registered under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition Excise Act.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners submits that petitioners are innocent and have falsely been implicated in the present case. They have no criminal antecedent. Further submission is that neither the said land nor the said pump house belongs to the petitioners from where the alleged recovery has been made. Petitioners have no concern with the alleged recovery.



Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioners be released on bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Special Judge, Excise Act, Patna in connection with Barh P.S. Case No. 326 of 2019 subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr. P.C.
