2 04-11-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the
offences punishable under Sections 413 and 414/34 of the
Indian Penal Code.

A stolen motorcycle was allegedly recovered from the
possession of the petitioner and co-accused Deepak Singh.
Petitioner has stated on oath that he has got no criminal
antecedent. Petitioner is in custody since 08.07.2019.
Investigation of the case is already complete.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has pointed out
discrepancy in search and seizure and non-compliance of
mandate under Section 100 Cr.P.C.

Considering the facts aforesaid, let the petitioner,
above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of



Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court below where the case is pending in connection with Paroo Police Station Case No. 276 of 2019, subject to the following conditions:-

(a) The petitioner shall fully cooperate with the investigation/trial of the case, failing which the learned court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.

(b) Both the bailors shall be resident of the territorial jurisdiction of the learned court below.
