4 17-04-2019 This application under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 and Article 215 of the Constitution of India has been filed by the petitioner for initiation of contempt proceeding against the opposite party no. 2-6 for their willful disobedience to the order dated 04.02.2016 passed in Cr.W.J.C. No. 791 of 2015.
