2 01-10-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned counsel for the State.

The petitioners are in custody since 30.07.2019 in connection with Shergatti (Dobhi) P.S. Case No. 349 of 2019 for the offence registered under Sections 414/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 30 (a) and 30(d) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the alleged recoveries were not made from the conscious possession of the petitioners. It is further submitted that the petitioners have no criminal antecedents.



Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioners, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Special Judge, Excise Gaya in connection with Sherghati (Dobhi) P.S. Case No. 349 of 2019.
