17    31-07-2019                      The learned counsel for the petitioner has filed a supplementary affidavit detailing therein the remaining claims on the head of the retiral benefits which are as follows:-

- (i) *Arrears of pension amounting to Rs. 4 lakhs and odd;*
- (ii) *Group Insurance of Rs. 2.4 lakhs and odd;*
- (iii) *Interest on the amount of Group Insurance @ 12.5 %; and*
- (iv) *Arrears of earned leave salary of Rs. 2.36 lakhs approximately.*

Having regard to the surviving claims of the



petitioner, as aforesaid, I deem it fit and proper to grant liberty to the petitioner to approach the Vice-Chancellor, B.R.A. Bihar University, Muzaffarpur by preferring a claim detailing therein the entire calculation so that the Vice-Chancellor, B.R.A. University, Muzaffarpur can take a decision regarding the same within a period of 8 weeks of filing of such claim by the petitioner and in case any amount is found payable, the said amount shall be paid to the petitioner by the learned Vice-Chancellor within a further period of eight weeks.

The writ petition stands disposed off on the aforesaid terms.
