5 19-09-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the respondents.

The present miscellaneous jurisdiction application has been filed for initiating a contempt proceeding against the respondents for willful, intentional and deliberate disobedience of the judgment dated 20.02.2017, passed in CWJC No.11196 of 2008.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the respondents that in pursuance to the judgment dated 20.02.2017 passed by this Court in CWJC No.11196 of 2008, the representation of the



petitioner has already been disposed of vide order No.8/मु04-35/2017 -1098, dated 23.10.2017 issued by the Director, Primary Education, Department of Education, Government of Bihar, as contained in 'Annexure-A' to the show cause filed on behalf of respondent no.3, the Director, Primary Education, Government of Bihar, Patna.
