2 16-10-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned counsel for the State.

The petitioners seek bail in a case for the offence registered under Sections 30(a), 37(b) and 37(c) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

The prosecution story, in brief, is that total 54 liters wine is said to have been recovered.

It has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that the petitioners are languishing in custody since 16.08.2019. The petitioners have got no criminal antecedent. The petitioners have falsely been implicated in the present case. Charge sheet/prosecution report has been submitted in the



present case. There is no allegation of tampering with the witnesses alleged against the petitioners. It is alleged that total 54 liters wine is recovered. There is no compliance of Section 100 Cr. P.C.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is named in the F.I.R/ Complaint Case.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioner above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned 2nd Additional Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge, Excise, Siwan, in connection with Mairwa P.S. Case No. 221 of 2019.
