2 14-11-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case for the offence
registered under Sections 363, 420, 467, 468, 471, 406 of the
IPC.

The prosecution story, in brief, is that the petitioner
alongwith others took Rs. 6,00,000/- from six persons in the
name of appointing themselves in foreign country.

It has been submitted by learned counsel for the
petitioner that the petitioner is languishing in custody since
25.06.2019. The petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. The
petitioner has falsely been implicated in the present case.
Charge sheet has been submitted in the present case. There is no
allegation of tampering with the witnesses alleged against the



petitioner. The petitioner provided engagement to the son of the informant in the country of *Malesia* where the son of the informant had to work for 14 hours in place of 12 hours. Hence, the present case was instituted by the informant against the petitioner for misleading the son of the informant. The allegations made by the informant are denied by the petitioner.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is named in the F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioner above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned A.C.J.M.- IV, Munger, in connection with Tarapur P.S. Case No. 03/2019, corresponding to G.R. No. 34 of 2019.
