A mobile phone was recovered by the police from co-accused Monu Yadav and Monu Yadav disclosed that he had purchased the same from this petitioner.

Considering the submission of the petitioner that only confessional statement of co-accused is there against the petitioner which is no evidence in the eye of law, a Bench of this Court had granted provisional bail and had called for case-diary.
