ORAL ORDER

2 06-11-2019 Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and
learned APP for the State.

By order dated 30.05.2019 passed in Cr. Misc.
No.35075/2019, bail was granted to the petitioner directing him
to surrender in the court below within a period of six weeks.

The instant application has been filed praying for
modification of the above order dated 30.05.2019 and praying
that the said order be modified and the period directing the
petitioner to surrender be extended by a further period of four
weeks.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and
