2 14-11-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered under
Sections 420, 379, 411 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation is that unknown persons stolen away the
tempo of the informant.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that
the petitioner is in custody since 26.06.2019. Charge sheet has
been submitted in this case. There is no allegation of tampering
of witnesses alleged against the petitioner. The petitioner has
falsely been implicated in the present case. The petitioner is not
named in the F.I.R. His name has come on confessional
statement of co-accused. The tempo in question has already



been recovered.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is not named in the F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned C.J.M., Aurangabad in connection with Aurangabad (Town) P.S. case No.105 of 2019.
