ORAL ORDER

2 14-10-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioners are in custody since 24.08.2019 in connection with Muffasil P.S. Case No.243 of 2019 registered for the offence under Sections 272, 273, 379, 34, 414 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 30(a)/32 of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the alleged recoveries were not from the conscious possession of the petitioners but from the Tata Manza vehicle in which the present petitioners were sitting. It is further submitted that the petitioners have no criminal antecedents.



Considering the aforementioned facts and circumstances, let the petitioners, above named, be released on bail on their furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the court of learned Additional Sessions Judge-III cum Special Judge (Excise Act), Munger, in connection with Muffasil P.S. Case No.243/19.
