2 14-10-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered under
Sections 379, 411, 413, 414, 401/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegedly, the three persons having unlocked the
motorcycle, tried to flee away with the motorcycle. The
petitioner was apprehended at the spot whereas two others
succeeded in fleeing away.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the
petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. There is no allegation
of tampering of witnesses alleged against the petitioner. The
petitioner is in custody since 30-05-2019. Charge sheet has
already been submitted. The allegation of attempt of theft is
denied by the petitioner. The petitioner was passing by the place



of occurrence, at the relevant time. The petitioner has been made accused in the present case due to mistake of fact.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is named in the Complaint Case/F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bettiah, West Champaran in connection with Majhaulia P.S. Case No. 246 of 2019.
