2 18-10-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection
with Basantpur P.S. Case No. 52 of 2019 registered under
Sections 366(A)/34 of the Indian Penal Code and section 8 of
the POCSO Act.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the
petitioner submits that petitioner is innocent and has falsely
been implicated in the present case. Petitioner has no criminal
antecedent. Further submission is that the victim in her
statement recorded under section 164 of the Cr. P.C. clearly
stated that co-accused Raja Ahmad forcibly took her and went to
Mumbai with her by train. Nothing specific has been alleged
against this petitioner.



Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioner be released on bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the 1st Additional Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge, Siwan in connection with Basantpur P.S. Case No. 52 of 2019, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr. P.C.
