2 18-12-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection
with Ramgarh P.S. Case No. 167 of 2019, registered under
Sections 366(A) and 120(B) of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner
submits that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been
implicated in the present case. He further submits that from
perusal of Annexure-2, it appears that the victim herself has
stated in her Affidavit that she was not kidnapped and all the
persons are innocent, who have been implicated in this case.
The petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

Having considered the above facts and circumstances
of the case, let the above-named petitioner be released on bail,



in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-1st, Kaimur at Bhabua in connection with Ramgarh P.S. Case No. 167 of 2019 subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
