APP for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case instituted for the
offences under Section 395 of the Indian Penal Code.

Prosecution allegation, in short, is that on the point of
pistol looted cash amount from the customer service centre and
fled away.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that
the petitioner is in custody since 20.7.2019 and has got no
criminal antecedent. Charge-sheet/prosecution report has been
submitted in this case. There is no allegation of tampering of
witnesses alleged against the petitioner. The petitioner is not
named in the F.I.R. Except for his self-confession, there is no
substantive evidence to suggest the implication of the petitioner



in the present case. There is no recovery of any incriminating articles from the possession of the petitioner. A T.I.P. was conducted but the petitioner was not identified.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is not named in the F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, it is directed that the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Sri Hemant Kumar, Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Muzaffarpur in connection with Karja P.S. Case No. 189/2019.
