3 20-11-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned
APP for the State.

The instant application for anticipatory bail has been filed by the petitioners apprehending their arrest in connection with Turkauliya (Banjaria) P.S. Case No. 284 of 2019 registered for the offence punishable under sections 302 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

As per allegation made in the F.I.R., all the three petitioners are alleged to have sprinkled kerosene oil on Wajeer Mukiya and set him on fire leading to his death.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners



that allegations against the three petitioners are general and omnibus in nature. There is no specific allegation as to who lit the fire and that the petitioner no. 2 happens to be a lady.

The application for bail is opposed by learned APP for the State.

Having heard the learned counsel for the parties and considering the fact that there is direct allegation against the petitioners, this court is not inclined to grant them bail and, as such, their application for anticipatory bail is rejected. They are directed to surrender in the court below within a period of six weeks.

However, taking into consideration that the petitioner no. 2 is a lady, the court may consider and dispose of the bail application of petitioner no. 2 at the earliest.
