Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the
offences punishable under Sections 392 and 394 of the Indian
Penal Code.

Petitioner is named in the first information report but
perusal of first information report goes to show that the
informant came to learn the name of the petitioner on the basis
of conversations of the culprits. Moreover, nothing has been
recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner, who
is languishing in jail custody since 29.07.2019 and having more
or less similar allegation, co-accused Dilip Yadav @ Madhu
Yadav has already been granted privilege of bail by co-ordinate



bench of this court, vide order, dated 15.10.2019, passed in Cr. Misc.
