ORAL ORDER

3 05-11-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection
with Kaler P.S. Case no. 26 of 2017, registered under Sections
406, 420 and 409/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

The accusation is that 1328 quintal of rice from
the BSFC godown under the conspiracy of Assistant Godown
Manager and Chairman PACS has been theft.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
petitioner is not named in the F.I.R. In course of investigation,
it has come in light that petitioner was one of the labourer, who
put the bags of rice on the truck. The petitioner has no criminal
antecedent.



Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioner, be released on bail, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Sherghati, Gaya in connection with Kaler P.S. Case No. 26 of 2017, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
