APP for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case instituted for the
offences under Sections 25(1-b)a, 26 and 35 of the Arms Act.

Prosecution case, in short, is that two pistols and five
live cartridges are recovered.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that
the petitioner is in custody since 14.2.2019. Charge-sheet has
been submitted in this case. There is no allegation of tampering
of witnesses alleged against the petitioner. It is alleged that two
pistols and five live cartridges are recovered. There is no
compliance of Section 100 Cr.P.C.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the



petitioner is named in the F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances,
it is directed that the petitioner, above named, be released on
bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with
two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of
learned A.C.J.M. XI, Bhagalpur in connection with Pirpainti
(Bakharpur) P.S. Case No. 27/19.
