2 16-10-2019 This is an application for grant of anticipatory bail in connection with Nath Nagar P. S. Case No. 194 of 2019, disclosing offences under Sections 420/34 of IPC.

As per F.I.R. petitioners are said to have got the land of the informant mutated in their name and the mutation order was canceled by the DCLR on an application by the informant.

Submission of the learned counsel for the petitioners is that they are sons of the elder brother of the informant and against the order cancelling the mutation in the name of the petitioner, they have challenged before the Additional Collector in the appeal.

Having heard both sides, considering the above submission, this application is allowed. Let the petitioners, above named, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the court below within six weeks, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of learned A.C.J.M.-I, Bhagalpur, connection with Nath Nagar P. S. Case No. 194 of 2019, subject to the condition laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
