ORAL ORDER

2 27-11-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and
learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in connection with Complaint Case No. 2237C/2017 registered for the offence punishable under Sections 498(A)/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 3/4 of the D.P. Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the present petitioners are the father-in-law and the mother-in-law of the victim girl and no specific role has been attributed to them. It is further submitted that the petitioners shall co-operate in the trial as and when required.

Considering the aforementioned facts and



circumstances, let the petitioners above named be released on bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned SDJM, Araria, in connection with Complaint Case No. 2237C/2017, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
