2 25-11-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the
offence punishable under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition
and Excise Act, 2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there is
recovery of 50 litres of Mahua wine in front of the house of the
petitioner. He submits that there is no recovery from the
conscious possession of the petitioner. He further submits that
petitioner has no criminal antecedent as stated in para-3 of the
bail application and he is languishing in judicial custody since
23.07.2019. He further submits that the petitioner has agreed to
deposit Rs. 10,000/- in the Patna High Court, Legal Services
Committee.



In the facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail **subject to deposit Rs.10,000/- in the Patna High Court, Legal Services Committee, Patna** on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Sessions Judge-II-cum-Special Judge, Nawada in connection with Roh Police Station Case No. 111 of 2019.
