2 16-10-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned
counsel for the State.

The petitioners seek bail in a case for the offence registered under Sections 272, 273 of the IPC and 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

The prosecution story, in brief, is that total 120.30 liters wine is said to have been recovered.

It has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that the petitioners are languishing in custody since 21.08.2019. The petitioners have got no criminal antecedent. The petitioners have falsely been implicated in the present case.



There is no allegation of tampering with the witnesses alleged against the petitioners. It is alleged that total 120.30 liters wine is recovered. There is no compliance of Section 100 Cr. P.C.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioners are named in the F.I.R/ Complaint Case.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioners above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned 2nd Additional Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge, Excise, Purnea, in connection with Sadar P.S. Case No. 431 of 2019, giving rise to Special Excise Case No. 665 of 2019.
