ORAL ORDER

2 17-10-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection with Maner P.S. Case No. 680 of 2018 for the offence punishable under Sections 406, 409, 420/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has not committed any offence. In fact, the petitioner has been appointed on the post of Supervisor on 06.06.2014 and the alleged embezzlement has been made prior to the appointment of the petitioner, therefore, no case of embezzlement is made out against the petitioner, this fact is



evident from Annexure-2 (series). Hence, the petitioner may be granted the privilege of anticipatory bail.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, let the, above named, petitioner in the event of surrender within a period of four weeks be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned J.M.-1st Class, Danapur (Patna) in connection with Maner P.S. Case No. 680 of 2018 subject to the conditions laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
