3 21-11-2019 Though the present writ petition was filed for quashing the order dated 31.08.2016 passed by the District Magistrate, Patna contained in Memo No. 2652 dated 01.09.2016, whereby and whereunder the arms license of the petitioner has been revoked, however, no such order has been annexed with the writ petition.

However, the respondents have filed a counter affidavit wherein the same has been annexed as Annexure-B.

At this juncture, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty to assail the aforesaid order dated 31.08.2016 passed by the District Magistrate, Patna contained in Memo
