2 05-11-2019 This application, for grant of anticipatory bail, arises out of Bhargama P.S. Case No. 128 of 2019, disclosing offences under Sections 341, 323, 354(B), 427, 379, 504, 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

As per F.I.R. dispute arose with respect to damage of electrical pole and there is allegation against the petitioners that they tried to outrage the modesty of informant and also snatched away golden chain.

Submission of learned counsel for the petitioners is that they are neighbours and dispute arose with respect to



electrical pole and just to make the case serious, allegation of outraging modesty and snatching away of golden chain has been levelled.

Heard learned A.P.P. also.

Having heard both sides, in view of the above facts, this application is allowed. Let the petitioners, above named, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the court below within six weeks, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty five Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Araria, in connection with Bhargama P.S. Case No. 128 of 2019, subject to the condition laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
