2 24-09-2019 The learned counsel for the petitioner has drawn attention of this Court to the notice dated 21.08.2018 issued by the Circle Officer, Udawantnagar, District Bhojpur to the private respondents no. 5 and 6, whereby and whereunder they had been directed to submit their show cause reply as to why encroachment in question made over the public land be not removed, however, it is submitted that no action is being taken by the Circle Officer, Udawantnagar, District Bhojpur, after issuance of the said notice.

If that be so, this Court is of the view that the Circle
