APP for the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the
offence punishable under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition
and Excise Act, 2016.

As per the allegation in the FIR, 162 litres of IMFL is
said to have been recovered from the Maruti Car from which the
petitioner and one another are said to have escaped.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner
that the petitioner is neither the owner of the said Maruti Car
and the allegation of the petitioner escaping is also false and
concocted. It is further submitted that the petitioner is in custody
since 28.06.2019.



Having heard learned counsel for the parties, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Sessions Judge-II-cum-Excise Court, Vaishali at Hajipur in connection with Mahnar Police Station Case No. 240 of 2019.
