2 04-11-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned
Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioners are languishing in custody for the offences punishable under Sections 413/414/467/468/471 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 30(a)/30(b)/30(c) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

Submission is that liquor was recovered from different places and the co-accused disclosed the name of the petitioners as co-culprit. The petitioners have got identical criminal antecedent.

Considering the entire facts aforesaid, let the petitioners, above named, be released on bail **after framing of**



the charges on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (Twenty Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court-below where the case is pending in connection with Sathi P.S. Case No.67 of 2019, with following conditions:

(a) Both the bailors shall be the resident of territorial jurisdiction of the learned Court-below.

(b) The petitioners shall fully cooperate with the investigation/trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioners.
