ORAL ORDER

2 07-11-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the

learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Fatuha
P.S. Case No. 418 of 2018 for the offence under Sections 420,
406, 504/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner
submits that the petitioner, who is of clean antecedent, is
innocent and has not committed any offence. In fact, there is
land dispute between the parties and on account of that this
petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case. The
dispute between the parties is purely civil in nature. The
petitioner is rotting in judicial custody since 10.08.2019.



Learned counsel for A.P.P. has opposed the prayer for bail and submitted that there was an agreement between the parties with respect to a piece of land and the petitioner with intention of cheating has executed the land to other purchaser even after taking the consideration amount from the informant and she is not ready to refund the consideration amount to the informant. Hence, she does not deserve the bail.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is not inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. Accordingly, the prayer for bail of this petitioner is rejected.
