ORAL ORDER

2 18-10-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the

learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection
with Bishampharpur P.S. Case No. 08 of 2019 for the offence
punishable under Sections 30(a), 38 and 41 of the Bihar
Prohibition and Excise Act, 2019.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner
submits that the petitioner, who is of clean antecedent, is
innocent and has not committed any offence. In fact, nothing
has been recovered from the conscious possession of the
petitioner. The petitioner is neither owner of the alleged
vehicle nor he is engaged in any illegal activity of liquor.
Hence, the petitioner may be granted the privilege of



anticipatory bail.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, let the, above named, petitioner in the event of surrender within a period of four weeks be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned A.D.J.-II -cum- Special Judge, Gopalganj in connection with Bishambharpur P.S. Case No. 08 of 2019 subject to the conditions laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
