Heard learned counsel for the petitioner; learned AC to AAG 15 for the State and Mr. Ajay Bihari Sinha, learned counsel for the LN Mithila University (hereinafter referred to as the 'University').



2. Pursuant to order dated 04.09.2019, the Incharge Registrar of the University is present and has filed third supplementary show cause.
