2 14-11-2019 This is an application for grant of anticipatory bail in connection with Aurangabad Town P. S. Case No. 99 of 2018 disclosing offences under Sections 147, 148, 149, 337, 323, 435, 436, 427, 307, 332, 333, 353, 153 (A), 295-A, 379, 122B of the IPC.

As per F.I.R. petitioners are named in the F.I.R. There is allegation of disrupting the communal harmony during the Ramnawmi.

Submission of the learned counsel for the petitioners is that they are named in the F.I.R., but nothing specific has been attributed against them. Apart from that there are two more cases that relates to the same occurrence.

Having heard both sides, considering the above submission, this application is allowed. Let the petitioners, above named, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the court below within six weeks, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of learned C.J.M., Aurangabad, in connection with Aurangabad Town P. S. Case No. 99 of 2018, subject to the condition laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
