2 17-10-2019 This is an application for grant of anticipatory bail in connection with Ghoshi P. S. Case No. 300 of 2019, disclosing offences under Sections 379, 420, 411 of IPC and Section 4/10 of the Bihar Minor Mineral Concession Rules, 1972 and Sections 2, 3 and 4 of Illegal Mining, Storage and Transportation Act, 2003 and Section 15 of the Environment Protection Act, 1986.

As per F.I.R. several trucks intercepted by the police, which were engaged in the mining of the sand.

Submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner is that F.I.R itself shows that no sand was found loaded in his truck and he has falsely been implicated in this case. He is ready to abide by any condition imposed upon him.

Heard learned A.P.P. also.



Having heard both sides, considering the above submission, this application is allowed. Let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within six weeks, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of learned A.C.J.M.-I, Jehanabad, in connection with Ghoshi P. S. Case No. 300 of 2019 subject to the condition laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
