Considering the fact that decision was taken by this Court relying upon the judgment of the Division Bench, the present writ application is disposed of in similar terms of C.W.J.C. No. 19333 of 2016 vide oral judgment dated 10.5.2018, the respondents are accordingly directed to examine the case of the petitioners in the light of decision dated 26.2.2018 in LPA No. 655 of 2015 and extend similar benefit to the petitioners, if it is found that the case of the petitioners is covered by the decision of the LPA Court.
