ORAL ORDER

2 04-12-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

In this case, the petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail
in connection with Complaint Case No.13-C/19, registered for
the offence punishable under Sections 341, 342, 323, 504 &
498A of the Indian Penal Code and Section 3/4 of Dowry
Prohibition Act.

Allegation against the co-accused including the
petitioner is to have tortured mentally and physically for non-
fulfillment of demand of dowry, however, counsel for the
petitioner submits that she is mother-in-law of the complainant.



Looking to the entire facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioner, above-named, be released on anticipatory bail in the event of her arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Begusarai in connection with Complaint Case No. 13-C/19, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
