ORAL ORDER

2 24-10-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioner is in custody since 07.09.2019 in connection with Basopatti P.S. Case No.220 of 2019 registered for the offence under Sections 272, 273 of the I.P.C. and Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the alleged recoveries were not from the conscious possession of the petitioner. It is further submitted that the petitioner is not having any criminal antecedents.

Considering the aforementioned facts and circumstances and that the petitioner has no criminal



antecedents, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on his furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the court of learned 2nd Additional Sessions Judge-Cum-Special Judge, Excise Act, Madhubani, in connection Basopatti P.S. Case No.220 of 2019.
