2 21-10-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered under
Sections 341, 323, 324, 307/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation against the petitioner is that he assaulted
the informant's mother-in-law by farsa causing head injury.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that
the petitioner is in custody since 27.08.2019 and has got no
criminal antecedent. There is no allegation of tampering of
witnesses alleged against the petitioner. The petitioner is alleged
to have assaulted upon the mother-in-law of the informant. The
nature of injury of the mother-in-law of the informant is simple.
Hence, no offence under Section 307 of the I.P.C. is made out.
Other co-accused has been granted bail vide Cr.Misc.No.34008



of 2019.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is named in the F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st class, Jhanjharpur, District Madhubani in connection with Laukaha P.S. case No.24 of 2019 corresponding to G.R. No.208 of 2019.
