2 06-11-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the

learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Rupaspur
P.S. Case No. 167 of 2019, registered for offence punishable
under Sections 457 and 380 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner
submits that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been
implicated in the present case. Further submission is that
similarly situated accused person has been granted bail by a co-
ordinate Bench of this Court 56453 of 2019 vide order dated
09.09.2019. The petitioner is in custody since 09.04.2019.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case
and the submissions advanced on behalf of the parties, let the



above-named petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-II, Danapur in connection with Rupaspur P.S. Case No. 167 of 2019.
