2 21-10-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case for the offence
registered under Sections 414, 120(B) of the IPC, 30(a), 32(ii),
38(ii) and 41(i) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise
(Amendment) Act, 2018.

The prosecution story, in brief, is that total 6056.67
liters wine is said to have been recovered.

It has been submitted by learned counsel for the
petitioner that the petitioner is languishing in custody since
19.08.2019. The petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. The
petitioner has falsely been implicated in the present case. There
is no allegation of tampering with the witnesses alleged against
the petitioner. It is alleged that total 6056.67 liters wine is



recovered from five different vehicles. None of the vehicle belongs to the petitioner. There is no compliance of Section 100 Cr. P.C.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is named in the F.I.R/ Complaint Case.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioner above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Sessions Judge-2nd-cum- Excise Court, Vaishali at Hajipur, in connection with Mahua P.S. Case No. 429 of 2019.
