ORAL ORDER

2 05-11-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection with Forbesganj (Simraha) P.S. Case No. 613 of 2019 registered under sections 467, 468, 406, 420, 120B read 34 of the I.P.C.

The allegation against the petitioner is that the petitioner along with other accused persons floated fake Non-Banking Financial Company in the name of Krishna Marketing Financial Service Ltd and accepted a sum of Rs. 2000/- from the local people with assurance that a sum of Rs. 40,000/- will be provided to them as loan within 15 days. It has further been alleged that innocent people have been cheated by the petitioner and other on the basis of false promise by a fake NBFC company.

Mr. Anil Prasad Singh, learned counsel appearing for



the petitioner submits that petitioner is innocent and has not committed any offence in the manner alleged. Learned counsel further submits that the name of the petitioner has been disclosed by co-accused, who is the owner of the bank as one of the partners and the petitioner has no concern with the said NBFC company.

After having heard learned counsel for the parties and taking into consideration the fact that the name of the petitioner has been disclosed by the owner of the the NBFC and the house owner in which the alleged NBFC company was running and the investigation is at initial stage, I am not inclined to exercise my discretion to grant anticipatory bail.

This application is, accordingly, dismissed.
