2 04-11-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in connection with
Madhuban P.S. Case No. 272 of 2018, registered for offence
punishable under Sections 356 and 379 of the Indian Penal
Code.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner
submits that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been
implicated on the basis of confessional statement of co-accused,
namely, Lalbabu Bhagat. Further submission is that nothing
incriminating has been recovered from the possession of the
petitioner and he was not put on Test Identification Parade. The
petitioner has no criminal antecedent and he is in custody since
17.05.2019.



Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the submissions advanced on behalf of the parties, let the above-named petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned 4th Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, East Champaran at Motihari in connection with Madhuban P.S. Case No. 272 of 2018.
