P.S. Case No. 67 of 2019 for the offence under Sections 413,

414, 467, 468 and 471 of the Indian Penal Code and Section

30(a), 30(b), 30(c) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act,

2016.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners

submits that the petitioners are innocent and have not

committed any offence. Nothing has been recovered from the

conscious possession of the petitioners and the petitioners

have no concern with the alleged recovery. The petitioners



are rotting in judicial custody since 16.08.2019.
