2 05-12-2019 Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned counsel appearing for the State.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that against the order, dated 10.07.2019, passed in Aaganbari Case No. 75 of 2018, rejecting the selection of the petitioner as Aagan Bari Sevika, Center No. 138, Ward No. 6, Tamaut Parsa Panchayat, the petitioner has filed an appeal, being Aaganbari Appeal No. 20 of 2019 (Annexure 4) before the District Magistrate, Madhepura, on 29.07.2019, which is still pending for disposal.

In view of the submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner, this writ application is **disposed of** with a direction to the District Magistrate, Madhepura (respondent no.



2) to dispose of the Aaganbari Appeal No. 20 of 2019
