3 19-11-2019 The petitioner has prayed for the following reliefs :-

“.....for issuance of direction upon the Respondents concerned to declare new amendment of Central Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989 is unconstitutional, void and not acted upon because the Section 110 of Motor Vehicle Act has power to make rules regarding to construction, equipment and



maintenance of the motor vehicle.”

After some arguments, Mr. Arun Kumar Sinha, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition with a liberty to file representation before the appropriate authority.

Permission granted.
